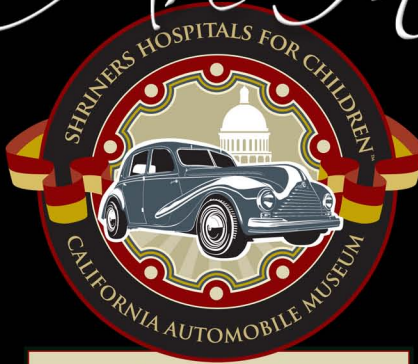

## Rules & Regulations

Classes are limited, and the organizing committee of the Wells Fargo Capitol Concours d'Elegance reserves the right to reject any automobile that does not meet the minimum standards for SCCA judging. The committee also reserves the right to change or combine classes depending on the number and type of entries. Vehicles must be driven through the checkpoint on the Concours field. Winners from the 2010 Concours are not eligible to win in their class, but are eligible to win special awards. No trailers will be allowed on the Concours field. An area for trailer parking will be provided. Displays of 'For Sale' or any other commercial signs are strictly prohibited on the field. Concours cars will be parked by class. Car clubs must enter as a group to have group parking. ALL CARS MUST CARRY A FIRE EXTINGUISHER.

## SCCA Judging & Scoring

Concours cars will be judged on interior, exterior, engine and chassis. Judging will be based on authenticity, general appearance, care and presentation. Any entrant may elect to have a car judged or entered as 'Exhibit Only'.

## Entry Fee: \$50 per vehicle

Application fees are non-refundable. Fees include: Admission for 2 adults, 2 lunch tickets and an event program. Additional entry tickets may be purchased for \$20 each.
